

Wireless Access

Wireless service means you can bring your properly-equipped laptop computer into the Library and get instant Internet access without being literally "plugged in."



Wireless card settings

Use the software that came with your computer or wireless card to configure settings and to verify a connection to our wireless network.

- SSID (network name) = JCPL-Public
- WEP = Disable WEP encryption
- Mode or Network Type = Infrastructure Mode or Access Point

How secure is the information I transmit over your wireless network?

The amount of security any user has depends completely on the security devices that each patron has installed on his/her own laptop. There are no "firewalls" or security devices on our wireless network.

You can easily connect to the Library's wireless printing system from your laptop. After sending your print request to a printer, use the Self Print Station to pay for and pick up your items.

What is wireless Internet access?

Wireless Internet access means you can access the Internet from inside the Library without any cables to connect you to an access port. Wireless service uses radio frequencies between your computer and the Internet to connect you.

How do I use it?

Just bring your own laptop with built-in Wi-Fi capabilities or with a Wi-Fi network card installed. Jefferson County Public Library (JCPL) uses the Wi-Fi standard (also known as IEEE 802.11g). Most Wi-Fi equipment will be compatible. No special passwords, user names or settings are required.

Staff at JCPL cannot assist you with your laptop, Wi-Fi network card or configuration. Due to liability concerns, Library staff members are not permitted to handle or adjust non-library equipment.
